NAA is pleased to launch the “MSc Aspire Award” campaign for nurses who are interested in registering for the Master of Science (MSc) in Clinical Nursing programme for its September 2025 admission.

To qualify, prospective students are required to send in their applications between 1st January and 29th August 2025, accept the university’s unconditional offer, and pay for the first instalment of the school fee within 30 calendar days from the offer issuance date.

Each successful application will be eligible for a S\$1,500 reward. The reward will be deducted from the applicant’s last payment instalment, i.e. the last payment instalment will be reduced by S\$1,500.

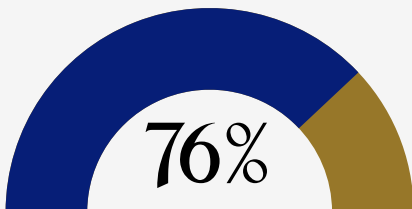

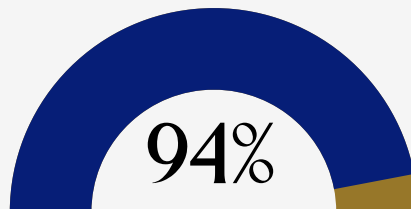

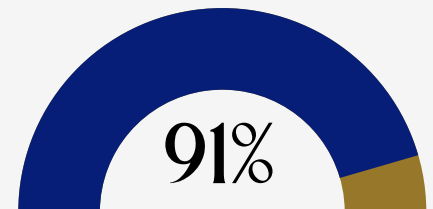
